Presentation

A new edition for a new ambition of the OSH Forum

The **3rd edition of the One Sustainable Health (OSH) Factory** will take place on **3 November 2026**, at the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) in Lyon, as part of One Health Day. It follows the first two editions, held in November 2025 and April 2026 on the occasion of the One Health Summit.



The OSH Factory is a collaborative, dynamic and inspiring space, designed to promote and develop innovative, multi-stakeholder and transdisciplinary projects collectively, based on the One Sustainable Health for ALL approach.

The first edition brought together 27 projects. At the second edition, 79 projects from over 70 countries were presented.

The third edition of the OSH Factory will mark an important milestone in the evolution of the OSH Forum. More than just another edition, it will herald **a new ambition**: to make the OSH Forum an international catalyst for projects capable of translating the One Sustainable Health for All approach into concrete solutions for local communities.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Faced with the growing challenges of climate change, water bankruptcy, the loss of biodiversity, pollution, health crises and social inequalities, it is no longer enough simply to recognise the interdependencies between human health, animal health, plant health and the health of ecosystems. The challenge now is to design, configure and support projects that **strengthen the resilience of local areas and preserve the conditions necessary for life.**

The implementation of the OSH for all approach helps to sustain what Baptiste Morizot and Laurent Neyret refer to as **the Earth's habitability**: the capacity of living systems to produce and maintain the conditions that make life possible. Air quality, water quality, soil quality, biodiversity, climate stability and the natural regulation of diseases all result from ongoing interactions between humans, animals, plants and micro-organisms. Preserving these interactions means preserving the very foundations of life and health.

This special edition will therefore feature a 'One Sustainable Health' Factory dedicated to promoting **the habitability of territories.**

Organised around four **Living Labs**, the OSH Factory will gather and convene proven demonstration projects and new frontline initiatives to be developed collectively.

Each Living Lab will address major challenges — around water as a sentinel, living soils & sustainable food, healthy & liveable cities, and around data management — by developing concrete, transferable solutions that can be rolled out in different contexts.

Audiences & Objectives

AUDIENCES

The OSH Factory will bring together researchers, local authorities, businesses, NGOs, international organisations, funders and practitioners to identify, develop and accelerate innovative, transdisciplinary and replicable projects.

Previous editions have attracted over 1,000 participants in person and 500 online.

OBJECTIVES OF THE LIVING LABS

- The OSH Factory will highlight demonstration projects on 'habitability' at the regional level across different contexts, addressing key challenges:

 Conserving water resources and adapting water quality to different uses

 Producing healthy food through living soils

 Designing cities that promote health for all

 Monitoring and anticipating trends through data

- Co-creating **practical solutions that address the challenge of habitability in line with the OSH approach, involving a wide range of stakeholders.**
- Helping to mobilise **long-term attention and support for OSH frontline projects.** The OSH Workshop on 3 November will be just one milestone in supporting these projects, in line with the OSH Forum's new ambition.

In the afternoon, participants will be divided into **four Living Labs running in parallel**, each dedicated to one of the major arenas explored during the morning's round-tables: Water as a sentinel, Living soils and sustainable food, Healthy and liveable cities, and One Health, data and AI.



Bringing together researchers, local authorities, businesses, NGOs, public and private institutions, funders and project leaders, these collaborative spaces will enable different areas of expertise to be combined in order to develop concrete solutions addressing key challenges identified. Discussions will draw on the experiences of **projects currently under development or already completed**, notably from the first two editions of the OSH Factory. They will identify common challenges and practical solutions that can be adapted and rolled out across different regions and contexts.

The work of the Living Labs will contribute to the production of an **international catalogue of One Sustainable Health solutions**, designed to inspire public and private decision-makers and accelerate the move towards action.

OSH Forum

Established in 2021, the One Sustainable Health (OSH) Forum is an international platform for cooperation that brings together experts, researchers, local authorities, businesses, NGOs and institutions from around 50 countries. It is supported by more than 150 organisations.



Organised around **10 International Working Groups (IWGs)**, the Forum **promotes interdisciplinary dialogue and the development of innovative projects** based on the One Health approach, aligned with the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The OSH Forum aims to:

- **Share scientific knowledge and lessons learnt** regarding the One Sustainable Health for All approach;
- **Connect international stakeholders to foster cooperation and synergies** between different disciplines and between the public and private sectors;
- **Co-developing pilot projects** with local stakeholders and communities to test and roll out practical solutions addressing the challenges of One Sustainable Health



The OSH Forum is led by the One Sustainable Health for All Foundation, under the auspices of the Institut Pasteur.

Review of the first two editions

OSH *for all* Lyon 2025 - 2 to 5 November 2025

To mark World One Health Day, Lyon hosted the **third edition of the One Sustainable Health for All Forum (OSH *for all* Lyon 2025)**. Over four days, experts in human and animal health and specialists in biodiversity and climate from more than 35 countries, alongside practitioners, organisations, foundations and businesses, gathered in Lyon.



Highlights included:

- **8 international preparatory conferences** (Balkans, Bangladesh, Brazil, China, India, Lebanon, Senegal, United States) aimed at integrating regional OSH approaches;
- A **scientific day** bringing together international experts, which highlighted practical recommendations for achieving Sustainable Health for All;
- The **Local Solutions Campus, held at Lyon City Hall**, brought together associations, foundations, and public and private organisations to present their local initiatives in support of sustainable health for all;
- The launch of the **first OSH Factory**, featuring around thirty international projects;
- **OSH-accredited side events** to strengthen the international community around the One Sustainable Health approach.
